### Suicide Risk

<b>CPG - Suicide Risk Tool</b>
<b>Suicide Risk Assessment and Management</b>
<b>1A) CURRENT SUICIDAL IDEATION AND PLANS</b>
<b>1B) HISTORY OF SUICIDAL IDEATION AND ATTEMPTS</b>
<b>1C) PRESENCE OF HIGH RISK FACTORS</b>
<b>1D) Plan for frequent evaluation for suicidal thinking or behavior in patients prescribed ANTI-DEPRESSANT and/or ANTICONVULSANT MEDICATIONS (assess if reviewing for MDD CPG)</b>
<b>1E) Assessment of LETHAL INTENT. Documentation shows interventions to address this with patient and response to measures.</b>
<b>1F) Assessment for access to any weapons or LETHAL MEANS, if suicidal.</b>
<b>2A) Developed plan to DIMINISH ACCESS TO WEAPONS/LETHAL MEANS, if suicidal.</b>
<b>2B) Developed PLAN FOR MAINTAINING SOBRIETY and discussed the role of substance use in increasing suicide risk.</b>
<b>2C) Attempted to INVOLVE FAMILY AND OTHER SUPPORT SYSTEM MEMBERS in suicide management plans, or documented why not appropriate.</b>
<b>2D) Documented ACTUAL FAMILY/SUPPORT SYSTEM INVOLVEMENT in suicide management plan.</b>
<b>2E) HALLUCINATION INTERVENTION (Intervention to alleviate command hallucinations, if present) (Assess if reviewing for Schizophrenia CPG)</b>
